

Summary

Project Improvements and Administrative Topics

The meeting participants discussed various topics, including online guest lectures, insurance for the Board of North America, and file management. Ganesh and Dhammpal talked about improving a project and following up on ideas. Dr. Radheshyam and Dr. Kanchan mentioned computations and bank-related matters. The conversation was somewhat disjointed, with participants frequently interrupting each other and switching topics abruptly.

Meeting Attendance and Welcome Address

The meeting began with Nutan addressing technical issues and requesting participants to join by their names for accurate attendance recording. Participants confirmed their attendance, and Dr. Rupesh Khubargar welcomed everyone, introducing himself as an assistant professor of commerce from Nutan Adarsh Arts, Commerce and Shrimati Moniban Haril Wagar Science College. The meeting was set to start soon, with Nutan noting that 1,986 people had already joined.

Workshop on NEP 2020 Implementation

The workshop, organized by IQC and the Department of Commerce, aims to provide guidance on implementing field projects and community engagement projects under the National Education Policy 2020. Dr. Tushar Chaudhary, a distinguished academician and Chairman of the Board of Studies in Commerce at RTM Nagpur University, will offer insights and address queries on project planning, student guidance, and evaluation. The workshop, which received an overwhelming response with over 600 registrations from across the country, will focus on clarifying the implementation process and providing practical solutions to commonly raised questions.

The meeting focused on a national workshop on project planning and execution, with Dr. Tushar Chaudhary delivering a key address on field projects, community engagement programs, and on-job training. He emphasized the importance of practical knowledge and its application in real-time scenarios, highlighting the role of field projects in bridging theoretical knowledge with practical implementation. Dr. Chaudhary also discussed the credit structure for these programs, stating that they are mandatory components of the curriculum, particularly for honors degrees, and outlined the duration and reporting requirements for on-job training and field projects.
